H-LINE VOLUME UPDATE

Due to a continued decrease in volume, the current H-Line schedule will transition to a **one-shift production schedule (Day Shift only)**.

Starting **Monday**, June 23, 2025, a solicitation process will begin for all **Chassis H-Line employees**. During this process, you will be asked to indicate your preference to:

- Work full-time
- Be laid off (partial or full)

Please note: Day shift is considered the lead shift. If both day and night shift sign up to work the full time, day shift will go to their regular job, night shift will go to available work. Until the solicitation process is complete, we will not know the numbers and the possible impact. We will be able to share more details and answer questions once this is process is complete.

This inverse TLO will remain in effect from July 7, 2025, to November 3, 2025 (subject to change based on operational needs).

It is always our intention and goal to keep as many members working as possible. Thank you for your continued commitment and understanding as we adjust to current business demands.

REMINDER: Rebalance Period – 2025: The company's rebalance period for 2025 will begin on <u>July 7</u>, <u>2025</u>, and conclude on <u>November 3, 2025</u>.
